AN ACT ALLOWING EMERGENCY PERSONNEL TO CARRY EPINEPHRINE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 201 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in the 1998 Official hereby amended by adding
3 the following paragraph:—
4 Additionally, the above listed emergency personnel epinephrine,
5 and shall be trained in the usage and administration of said epineph-
6 rine.

1 SECTION 2. The first paragraph of section 6 of chapter of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in the 1998 Official hereby amended by
3 adding the following sentence:— shall also include the administra-
4 tion of epinephrine.
