AN ACT TO ENSURE SANITARY CONDITIONS IN PHYSICIANS' OFFICES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 5 of Chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
- 2 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended, in paragraph 2, by
- 3 inserting the following sentences at the end thereof:—
- 4 “Said unit may inspect any licensee's office at any time during
- 5 regular business hours, and without notice, for the purposes of
- 6 verifying that the office is clean and sanitary, that the licensee has all
- 7 appropriate and necessary equipment as determined by the board and
- 8 that patient records are maintained in accordance with applicable
- 9 laws and regulations.”
