AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DEFINITION OF A PHARMACY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 112, section 39C of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 2005 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the word
3 “infusion,” in place of the word fusionist, everywhere that the word
4 fusionist appears in this section, and replacing the last sentence of
5 this section with the following sentence:—
6 “For the purposes of this section, the term home infusion phar-
7 macy shall mean a pharmacy which dispenses pharmaceuticals,
8 sterile intravenous drugs and nutritional products ordered by physi-
9 cians to patients in their homes and other similar institutional sites of
10 care as determined by the board.”
