AN ACT EXPANDING THE LEAD PAINT ABATEMENT LOAN PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 197E of Chapter 111 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the words “the proportion of res-
3 dents of low and moderate income” the following words:— “based
4 on the federal poverty level.”

1 SECTION 2. Section 197E of Chapter 111 of the General Laws
2 is further amended by inserting at the end thereof the following para-
3 graph:—
4 Said regulations shall include provisions to permit applicants who
5 are at or reasonably above the federal poverty level to be deemed
6 eligible for such loans, provided they satisfy all other terms and con-
7 ditions of this program’s regulations.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
