AN ACT REQUIRING A CERTAIN DECAL ON MOTOR VEHICLES OPERATED BY
PERSONS WITH LEARNER'S PERMITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 8B of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
- 2 2002 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end, the
- 3 following sentence.:
- 4 The registrar shall make available a suitable decal to be affixed to
- 5 the motor vehicle which is being driven by a person with a learner's
- 6 permit which shall be displayed whenever such person is driving and
- 7 shall indicate the status of the driver.
