AN ACT RELATIVE TO FIREARMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Subsection (i) of Section 131 of Chapter 140 of the General
- 2 Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended
- 3 by striking out the second paragraph and inserting in place thereof
- 4 the following paragraph:—
- 5 Any person 70 years or older and any law enforcement officer
- 6 applying for a license to carry firearms through his employing
- 7 agency shall be exempt from the requirement of paying a renewal
- 8 fee for a Class A or Class B license to carry.
