AN ACT REGULATING UNIFORMED PRIVATE SECURITY FIRMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation
- 2 to the contrary, any uniformed watch, guard or patrol employee
- 3 licensed under Massachusetts General Law Chapter 147 Section 25,
- 4 shall comply with any ordinance or town by-law or rules, regulations
- 5 or licensing promulgated by the chief of police in any city or town
- 6 with a population over 50,000 people.
