AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR DETERMINING PAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding Section 8 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, or
2 any other general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary,
3 the department of state police shall credit Paul J. Thomas a member
4 of the Massachusetts state police with creditable service from Sep-
5 tember 20, 1981 to January 7, 1999 the period of time he was retired
6 for disability for the purpose of determining his pay. Within 30 days
7 of the effective date of this Act the Massachusetts state police shall
8 pay the difference between the highest salary step for Trooper First
9 Class contained in the State Police Association of Massachusetts
10 contract and the salary he has been paid since his return to service
11 from involuntary disability retirement.
