## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 1998 Official Edition, is hereby amended in the def-  
3 inition of "Regular compensation" by striking out the third sentence.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule  
2 or regulation to the contrary, all regular deductions which have been  
3 withheld pursuant to the provisions of Section 22 of said Chapter 32  
4 on account of compensation received by a member of said teachers'  
5 retirement system under the terms of an annual contract for addi-  
6 tional services in a public day school or compensation for services  
7 rendered by said member in connection with a school lunch program  
8 or for services in connection with a program of instruction of phys-  
9 ical education and athletic contests as authorized by Section 47 of  
10 Chapter 71 shall be returned to such member in one sum or in  
11 installments, as determined by the teachers' retirement board, estab-  
12 lished pursuant to Section 16 of Chapter 15 of the General Laws,  
13 with regular interest thereon, upon the effective date of his retire-  
14 ment.

1 SECTION 3. The provisions of Section 1 shall apply only to per-  
2 sons who enter or re-enter service as a member of the teachers'  
3 retirement system, established under the provisions of said Chapter  
4 32, on or after to the effective date of this act.
