AN ACT RELATIVE TO RETIREMENT CREDIT FOR CERTAIN COURT OFFICERS
EMPLOYED IN THE TRIAL COURT DEPARTMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, any
- 2 court officer who was classified as a per diem and was entitled to
- 3 benefits under a collective bargaining agreement shall be entitled to
- 4 buy back for retirement purposes the years for which he or she did
- 5 not receive retirement credit while covered under the collective bar-
- 6 gaining agreement.
