AN ACT RELATIVE TO EMPLOYEES OF SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the  
2 contrary, all employees of a Sheriff's Department who are correc-  
3 tional officers shall be subject to the provisions of Chapter 31 of the  
4 General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1 of this  
2 act, all Sheriff Department correctional officers on the effective date  
3 of this act shall be deemed to have been appointed in their current  
4 positions under the provisions of said Chapter 31.
