AN ACT RELATIVE TO LIQUOR LICENSES IN THE TOWN OF BURLINGTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The town of Burlington is authorized to issue, within the develop-
- 2 ment known as the northwest park planned development district, 8
- 3 additional licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages to be drunk on
- 4 premises, 2 additional licenses for the sale of wine and malt bever-
- 5 ages to be drunk on the premises, and 2 additional licenses for the
- 6 sale of wine and malt beverages not to be drunk on premises.
