

HOUSE No. 2554

By Ms. Grant of Beverly (by request), petition of Brian R. Scanlan that the Teachers' Retirement Board be directed to grant creditable service to Brian R. Scanlan for service outside of the Commonwealth Public Service.

AN ACT GRANTING CERTAIN CREDITABLE SERVICE TO BRIAN R. SCANLAN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (4) of section 3 of
2 chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002 Official
3 Edition, the Massachusetts teacher's retirement board is hereby
4 authorized and directed to grant Brian R. Scanlan creditable service
5 for the period of September, 1974 to June, 1977, inclusive, during
6 which he served as an elementary school guidance counselor in
7 Nova Scotia, Canada; provided, however, that he shall pay into the
8 annuity savings fund, in one sum or in installments, as the board
9 shall determine, an amount equal to the regular deductions which
10 would have been deducted for said period together with regular
11 deductions which would have been deducted for said period together
12 with regular interest thereon.

13 In the event that Brian R. Scanlan shall retire before the comple-
14 tion of said payments, he shall, in addition to his actual membership
15 service, be entitled to credit for the portion of the creditable service
16 which the total of his actual payments, together with regular interest
17 thereon to the date such retirement becomes effective, bears to the
18 total amount of what his payment, together with regular interest
19 thereon, would have been had he made a payment in one sum on the
20 effective date of his retirement.
