## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF MASSPORT EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the Massachusetts General Laws is  
2 hereby amended to include mechanical maintenance men, consisting  
3 of plumbers, steam pipe fitters, facility technicians, building equip-  
4 ment mechanics, building mechanical maintenance man A, mechan-  
5 ical department foremen and immediate supervisors located at  
6 MASSPORT located at the Logan International Airport located in  
7 the City of Boston in Group 2 of the retirement system.
