AN ACT AUTHORIZING GARY W. TIRRELL TO RECEIVE ADDITIONAL CREDITABLE SERVICE FROM THE MASSACHUSETTS TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding Chapter 32 of the General Laws or any other
2 special or general law to the contrary, the Massachusetts teachers'
3 retirement board shall credit Gary W. Tirrell with the service he ren-
4 dered between 1972 and 1979 as an elected member of the city of
5 Westfield parks and recreation commission for the purpose of deter-
6 mining a retirement allowance under Chapter 32. Eligibility for this
7 creditable service shall be conditioned upon payment to the Massa-
8 chusetts teachers' retirement board of a sum equal to the amount
9 which would have been deducted under chapter 32 during this
10 period if Gary Tirrell had been a member of a retirement system
11 under Chapter 32 and had been compensated at the rate of \$500 per
12 year, plus regular interest on that amount. The payment shall be
13 made in 1 sum or in installments as the Massachusetts teachers'
14 retirement board shall prescribe.
