AN ACT RELATIVE TO CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR VETERANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 32 Section (h), paragraph 1 of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in the 2004 Official Edition is hereby amended by adding
- 3 at the end thereof the following sentence:—
- 4 Any member who is a Veteran, as defined in Section 1 of said
- 5 Chapter 115 as amended, who retired prior to January 1996, may be
- 6 granted creditable service for service to the Commonwealth or any
- 7 municipality or county and such service may be compensated in a
- 8 manner deemed acceptable by the retirement system with jurisdic-
- 9 tion over said retiree.
