AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE TERM OFFICER, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER THIRTY-TWO.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Subdivision (1) of Section 26 of Chapter 32, as appearing in the
- 2 1994 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in lines 3 and
- 3 4, the definition of “Officer”, and inserting in place thereof the
- 4 following:—
- 5 “Officer”, an officer of the department of state police appointed
- 6 thereto under Section ten of Chapter twenty-two C or appointed
- 7 under said Section ten, for a period of not less than ten years and
- 8 subsequently appointed as a special state police officer under the
- 9 provisions of section fifty-eight of chapter twenty-two C.
