AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING PAROLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 149 of chapter 127 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 2002 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after
3 the second sentence the following sentence:— Anyone accused of
4 violation of parole, shall not be released from custody, without a
5 hearing on the merits.
