AN ACT TO MAKE PROVISIONAL EMPLOYEES IN THE LABOR SERVICE  
PERMANENT EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 31 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after Section 28 the following:—
- 3 Section 28A. All employees employed by the Commonwealth
- 4 and by cities, towns, and districts, in the Commonwealth in a
- 5 labor service position for two years or more shall be made perma-
- 6 nent employees. The Personnel Administration shall annually
- 7 report to the General Court the number of labor service employees
- 8 made permanent.
