By Mr. Scaccia of Boston, petition of Angelo M. Scaccia for legislation to prohibit decreases in permanent position accounts by the state system of higher education for the purpose of contracting out services. Public Service.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DECREASE BY INTERCHANGE OF SUBSIDIARY ACCOUNTS OF EMPLOYEES IN THE STATE SYSTEM OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 29 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 in Section 29 by adding in the first sentence the following lan-  
3 guage:—

4 and, provided further that no interchange out of subsidiary  
5 account “01 salaries, Permanent Positions” to the accounts entitled  
6 “03 Contracted Employees Salaries” and “07 Laboratory and Med-  
7 ical Supplies and Expenses” for the purpose of contracting out serv-  
8 ices currently provided by state employees in the system of higher  
9 education shall be approved.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 29 is further amended in Section 29A by  
2 adding the following after the words “state positions”, and no “03”  
3 consultant shall be hired for an “01” position in the system of higher  
4 education without following the regular procedures for filling vacan-  
5 cies including proper posting of positions.
