AN ACT RELATIVE TO CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
2 the contrary, any veteran, as defined in clause forty-third, section 7,
3 chapter 4 of the General Laws, who buys back creditable service for
4 purposes of retirement under the provisions of Chapter 71 of the
5 Acts of 1996, shall purchase such creditable service for their military
6 service based upon ten percent of their salary when he or she
7 first became employed by the Commonwealth or any political
8 subdivision thereof.
