By Ms. Wolf of Cambridge, petition of Alice K. Wolf and Stephen Stat Smith for legislation to authorize the State Board of Retirement to grant certain creditable service for retirement purposes to Sherry Leffert of the city of Cambridge. Public Service.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE BOARD OF RETIREMENT TO GRANT CREDITABLE SERVICE TO SHERRY LEFFERT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws or  
2 any other general or special law to the contrary, and in order to pro-  
3 mote the public good, the state board of retirement shall credit  
4 Sherry Leffert of the city of Cambridge with creditable service for  
5 the years 1981 through 1987 for the purpose of determining her  
6 superannuation retirement allowance pursuant to the provisions of  
7 paragraph (a) of subdivision (2) of section 5 of said chapter 32.  
8 Eligibility for this creditable service shall be conditioned upon pay-  
9 ment by said Sherry Leffert into the state employees' retirement  
10 system of an amount equal to the amount that would have been  
11 deducted under said chapter 32 if she had received regular compen-  
12 sation during this period at an annual rate equal to the annual rate of  
13 regular compensation that she was receiving immediately before this  
14 period together with regular interest thereon. Such repayment shall  
15 be made in 1 lump sum or in installments as the state retirement  
16 board shall prescribe.
