AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A CERTAIN EXEMPTION TO THE MOTOR VEHICLE  
EXCISE TAX.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 1 of Chapter 60A of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 2002 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
- 3 sixth paragraph the following paragraph:—
- 4 The excise tax imposed by this section shall not apply to a motor
- 5 vehicle owned and registered by a survivor of Pearl Harbor, pro-
- 6 vided, however, that the excise tax shall not apply to a motor vehicle
- 7 owned and registered by the survivor of Pearl Harbor, until such
- 8 time as the surviving spouse remarries or fails to renew such regis-
- 9 tration.
