AN ACT RELATIVE TO DRIVERS' LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (f) of Section 22 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws as
2 appearing in the 2004 official edition is hereby amended by adding
3 the following new paragraph:—

4 “The registrar shall promulgate regulations setting forth applic-
5 able periods of suspensions for particular offenses, and appropriate
6 guidelines for hardship license eligibility subject to such terms and
7 conditions as the registry may prescribe. Nothing in this subsection
8 shall be construed to give the registrar the authority to suspend or
9 revoke for a court finding other than a conviction, delinquent, or
10 responsible finding, nor shall any other such finding be used in con-
11 sideration for hardship eligibility.”
