AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY BOARD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1-2 of Chapter 91 App. of the Massachusetts General  
2 Laws, as appearing in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended  
3 in the second paragraph by inserting after the words “and shall  
4 include” the following:—  
5 at least one member who resides in either towns of Concord, Lin-  
6 coln, Lexington or Bedford, to be chosen from a list of 5 qualified  
7 candidates submitted by Hanscom Area Towns Selectmen (HATS),  
8 Massport’s Hanscom Advisory Board, and at least one member who  
9 resides in either the municipalities of Winthrop, Revere or the  
10 section of Boston known as “East Boston”, to be chosen from a list  
11 of candidates submitted by the selectmen of said towns and the  
12 mayor of Boston.
