AN ACT RELATIVE TO ROOM RENTAL RATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 1.) Section 1 of Chapter 64G of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting, after subsection (j), the following new subsec-
3 tion:—
4 (k) “Friends and Family Rate”, rooms rented to employees of an
5 Operator and relatives and friends of employees at a rate determined
6 by the Operator.
7 2.) Section 1, subsection (j) of said chapter 64G is hereby
8 amended by inserting, after the word “whatsoever.”, the
9 following:—
10 “Rent for rooms rented under a Friends and Family Rate shall be
11 based solely on the rate determined by the Operator.”
