AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A CERTAIN EXEMPTION FROM THE MOTOR VEHICLE
EXCISE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The excise imposed by Section 1 of Chapter 60A of
2 the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, shall
3 not apply to a motor vehicle owned and registered by a member of
4 the armed forces while such member is on active service.

1 SECTION 2. The words “armed forces”, as used in this act, shall
2 mean the following: —
3 United States Army, Army of the United States, United States
4 Navy, United States Naval Reserve, United States Coast Guard,
5 United States Coast Guard Reserve, Army Nurse Corps, Navy Nurse
6 Corps, United States Air Force, and United States Air Force
7 Reserve, including women’s branches of said armed forces.
