AN ACT TO ENSURE TRANSPARENCY IN EXECUTIVE COMPENSATION AT PRIVATE SECTOR HUMAN SERVICE AGENCIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 29: Section 29B shall be amended by adding the
- 2 following sentences:—
- 3 Organizations providing social, rehabilitative, health, or special
- 4 education services yearly shall report to the commissioner the
- 5 following information regarding the five highest paid employees of
- 6 the organization:— yearly salary, payments to retirement and/or pen-
- 7 sion plans, travel and or car allowance, housing allowance, and all
- 8 other compensation for said employees; such reports shall also
- 9 include the percentage of said employee's compensation package
- 10 that is derived from: state contract dollars, municipal contract dol-
- 11 lars, federal contract dollars, investments income and charitable
- 12 donations to the organization.
