AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BOARD OF ELECTRICAL EXAMINERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 13. Section 32. Board; membership; appointment; term;
- 2 executive secretary; compensation and expenses.
- 3 In line three after the word “and” striking the word eight and
- 4 adding the word; twelve.
- 5 In line twelve after the word “electrician;” striking the word one
- 6 and adding the word; five.
- 7 In line 16 after the word “Purposes” adding the words; and whom
- 8 at the time of appointment shall be a member or an employee of a
- 9 member of a trade union or a party or an employee of a party to a
- 10 contract with a trade union;.
