AN ACT TO FURTHER STREAMLINE THE PERMITTING PROCESS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 27C of Chapter 9 of the General Laws, as  
2 most recently amended by section 7 of chapter 254 of the Acts of  
3 1988, is hereby further amended by inserting the following para-  
4 graph:—

5 Notwithstanding the provisions of Section twenty six, actions  
6 governed by this section shall be under the supervision and control  
7 of the secretary of the executive office of environmental affairs.

1 SECTION 2. The secretary of the executive office of environ-  
2 mental affairs is hereby authorized and directed to appoint such  
3 assistants and employees as deemed necessary to implement the pro-  
4 visions of this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on July the first, two thou-  
2 sand and seven.
