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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand and Seven.

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AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS AT THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 465 of the Acts of 1956 is  
2 hereby amended by adding at the end the following:—  
3 (s) The term “impacted communities” shall refer to any city,  
4 town, or neighborhood of a city that is located within the noise con-  
5 tour boundaries established by the Federal Aviation Administration  
6 and the Authority for the purpose of the residential soundproofing  
7 program or a host community of an airport operated by the  
8 Authority.

1 SECTION 2. Section 2 of Chapter 465 of the Acts of 1956 is  
2 hereby amended by striking the word “seven” in line 12 and  
3 inserting in place the following:— “nine”.

1 SECTION 3. Section 2 of Chapter 465 of the Acts of 1956 is  
2 hereby amended by adding in line 22 after the word “Authority” the  
3 following:—  
4 “Two such members shall be residents of an impacted community  
5 as defined by Section 1(s) of this act.”

1 SECTION 4. Section 2 of Chapter 465 of the Acts of 1956 is  
2 hereby amended by striking the word “Four” in lines 67 and 68 and  
3 inserting in place, in each instance, the following:— “Five”

1 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
