AN ACT PROVIDING FOR FURNISHING A SUMMARY OF THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST LAW TO STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 23 of Chapter 268A of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out paragraph (f) and inserting in place thereof the following
4 paragraph:—

5 (f) Every state, county and municipal employee shall, within 30
6 days of becoming such an employee, be furnished with a summary
7 of Chapter 268A prepared or approved by the commission and sign a
8 written acknowledgment that he has been provided with such a sum-
9 mary. Municipal employees shall be furnished the summary by, and
10 file such an acknowledgment with, the city or town clerk. Appointed
11 state and county employees shall be furnished the summary by, and
12 file such an acknowledgment with, such employee's appointing
13 authority or his designee. Elected state and county employees shall
14 be furnished the summary by, and file such an acknowledgment
15 with, the commission.

1 SECTION 2. Every state, county and municipal employee who,
2 on the effective date of this act, is such an employee shall, within 90
3 days of the effective date of this act, be furnished with, and sign and

4 file a written acknowledgment that he has been provided, a summary
5 of Chapter 268A prepared or approved by the commission, as pro-
6 vided in paragraph (f) of Section 23 of said Chapter 268A as
7 amended by Section 1 of this act.
