AN ACT AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING PUBLIC TOILETS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 33 the following section:—
- 3 Section 33A. The entrance door to all rooms containing toilets or
- 4 water closets available to the public or to persons engaged in the
- 5 production or service of food shall open outwards.
