AN ACT LIMITING A COST OF CELLPHONE CALLS TO USERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
- 2 the contrary, no person, consumer or entity shall be charged or billed
- 3 any amount for making a cellphone call to any 800 number.
