AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ABRAHAM LINCOLN BICENTENNIAL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 In recognition and observance of the bicentennial of president  
2 Abraham Lincoln in 2009 the Commonwealth through the secretary  
3 of state shall officially recognize this bicentennial with appropriate  
4 recognition, ceremonies, and education programs throughout the  
5 Commonwealth to include but not be limited to education forums at  
6 all public education institutions and any other forums deemed appro-  
7 priate. The secretary of state shall make available to all public and  
8 private entities all information necessary for this historic project.
