AN ACT RELATIVE TO COMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 6 of Chapter 90F, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edi-
- 2 tion, is hereby amended by striking, in lines 19 and 20 the words
- 3 “non-English speaking” and adding at the of said section, the
- 4 following:—
- 5 The Registrar shall administer, the tests prescribed under this
- 6 section in Portuguese and Spanish, if so requested by the applicant,
- 7 and in any other language he deems necessary, as reasonable accom-
- 8 modation for limited-English speaking applicants for licenses to
- 9 operate commercial motor vehicles.
