AN ACT RELATIVE TO MOTOR VEHICLE EXCISE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after Section 33A the following section:—
- 3 Section 33A½. When the holder of a registration voluntarily can-
- 4 cels such and returns the registration plates to the registry, he shall
- 5 be given a receipt which shall include a notice instructing to notify
- 6 his local assessors of his action and to inform them he is no longer
- 7 subject to the excise imposed under Chapter 60A.
