AN ACT CELEBRATING RACIAL HARMONY, DIVERSITY AND TOLERANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general law to the contrary, state route 28
2 from south street in the town of Stoneham to the Reading town line,
3 shall hereby be designated Equality Road as a celebration of
4 equality, racial harmony, diversity and tolerance. The department of
5 highways shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing such
6 designation in compliance with the standards of said department.
