**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year Two Thousand and Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TRANSPORTATION FINANCE COMMISSION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 13 of Chapter 196 of the acts of 2004 is hereby amended  
2 in paragraph 2 by striking the first sentence and inserting in place  
3 thereof the following:—  
4 The commission shall have 14 members, including the  
5 following:— 5 members who shall not be employees of the execu-  
6 tive branch and who shall reside in different geographic regions of  
7 the Commonwealth, 1 of whom shall be a representative of the Con-  
8 struction Industries of Massachusetts, to be appointed by the gov-  
9 ernor to serve terms of 2 years; 3 members, who shall not be  
10 members of the general court and who shall reside in different geo-  
11 graphic regions of the Commonwealth, to be appointed by the presi-  
12 dent of the senate to serve terms of 2 years; 3 members, who shall  
13 not be members of the general court and who shall reside in different  
14 geographic regions of the Commonwealth, to be appointed by the  
15 speaker of the house of representatives to serve terms of 2 years; a  
16 representative of the Massachusetts Taxpayers Foundation; a repre-  
17 sentative of the Massachusetts Business Roundtable; and a represen-  
18 tative of the Massachusetts Motor Transportation Association.
