AN ACT NAMING A CERTAIN BRIDGE IN THE TOWN OF DALTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The bridge across the Housatonic River on Route 8
2 near the corner of Depot and Main Streets in the Town of Dalton,
3 shall be designated and known as the Benjamin-Muraca Memorial
4 Bridge, in the memory of Gary Thomas Benjamin and Patrick-John
5 Muraca who were Vietnam Veterans killed while protecting the
6 United States of America in Vietnam.

1 SECTION 2. The department of highways shall erect suitable
2 markers bearing said designation in compliance with the standards
3 of said department. The department of public works for the town of
4 Dalton shall be responsible for the maintenance of said markers.
