AN ACT NAMING A CERTAIN BRIDGE IN THE TOWN OF HINSDALE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The bridge across the Housatonic River on Main St.
2 in the Town of Hinsdale, shall be designated and known as the
3 Hinsdale Veterans Memorial Bridge, in memory of the residents of
4 Hinsdale who died while protecting the United States of America.

1 SECTION 2. The department of highways shall erect suitable
2 markers bearing said designation in compliance with the standards
3 of said department. The department of public works for the town of
4 Hinsdale shall be responsible for the maintenance of said markers.
