AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN MASSACHUSETTS VETERANS FROM TOLL CHARGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Subsection (b) of Section 10 of Chapter 81A of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended  
3 by inserting after the word “business”, in line 55, the following  
4 words:— “; provided that the authority shall not charge or collect a  
5 toll from Congressional Medal of Honor recipient residents and 100  
6 percent disabled American veteran residents.”
