AN ACT PERMITTING THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION  
AUTHORITY TO STUDY THE CONSTRUCTION OF A RAIL EXTENSION TO  
THE TOWN OF MILLIS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special legislation to the contrary,
- 2 the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority is hereby directed
- 3 to study the construction of the extension of the existing Needham
- 4 commuter rail line into the town of Millis, and the construction and
- 5 maintenance of all necessary stations on said extension.
