AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A DISTINCTIVE REGISTRATION PLATE FOR PARATROOPERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 2 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by Section 6 of Chapter 220 of the acts of 2004, is hereby
- 3 further amended by adding the following paragraph:—
- 4 The registrar shall furnish without charge to owners of private
- 5 passenger motor vehicles who are veterans as defined in clause
- 6 forty-third of Chapter 7 and who as paratroopers and upon evidence
- 7 deemed satisfactory by the registrar, distinctive, registration plates
- 8 bearing the words “PARATROOPER” for a private passenger motor
- 9 vehicle owned and principally used by such paratrooper.
