AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF HEADLIGHTS ON MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 15 of Chapter 85 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
- 2 1998 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the first
- 3 sentence the following sentence:—
- 4 Every vehicle shall display lights so as to be visible from the front
- 5 and the rear whenever the windshield wipers of such vehicle are in
- 6 use.
