### AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS FROM PAYING TOLLS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of Section 10 of Chapter 81A of the  
2 General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby  
3 amended by adding the following paragraph:—

4 The authority shall not charge or collect a toll for transit over the  
5 turnpike and the different parts and sections thereof by private pas-  
6 senger vehicles registered to persons 70 years of age or older. The  
7 authority shall issue passes or stickers to carry out the provisions of  
8 this paragraph.

1 SECTION 2. Subsection (b) of Section 10 of Chapter 81A of the  
2 General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by adding the  
3 following paragraph:—

4 The authority shall not charge or collect a toll for transit through  
5 the Callahan Tunnel, the Sumner Tunnel or the Ted Williams Tunnel  
6 by private passenger vehicles registered to persons 70 years of age  
7 or older. The authority shall issue passes or stickers to carry out the  
8 provisions of this paragraph.
