AN ACT RELATIVE TO REGISTRATION AND LICENSE FEES FOR CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (2) of Section 33 of Chapter 90 of the  
2 General Laws, as amended by Section 8 of Chapter 87 of the acts of  
3 2000, is hereby further amended by adding the following sen-  
4 tence:—  
5 No fee shall be collected hereunder for the registration of motor  
6 vehicles owned by persons 65 years of age or older.

1 SECTION 2. Paragraph 21 of said Section 33 of said Chapter 90,  
2 as so amended is hereby further amended by adding the following  
3 sentence:—  
4 No fee shall be collected for a license or renewal thereof issued to  
5 a person 65 years of age or older.
