AN ACT RELATIVE TO RAILROAD CROSSINGS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 84 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by  
3 striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following sentence:—

5 Highways and town ways shall be kept in repair at the expense of  
6 the town in which they are situated, so that they may be reasonably  
7 safe and convenient for travelers at all seasons.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 1 of said Chapter 84, as so appearing, is  
2 hereby further amended by adding the following sentence:—

3 Railroad crossings at grade with such highways and town ways  
4 shall be kept in a reasonable state of repair at the expense of the  
5 owner of said railroad crossing.
