AN ACT RELATIVE TO AMBER ALERTS IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to  
2 the contrary, once the department of public safety has issued an  
3 amber alert, said department shall notify the department of probation  
4 to utilize the Global Positional System satellite to determine if there  
5 are any sex offenders in the surrounding area where the amber alert  
6 was initiated.
