AN ACT AUTHORIZING CITIES AND TOWNS TO CHARGE PAYMENT OBLIGATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, any
- 2 city or town may charge to any enterprise fund a payment in lieu of
- 3 tax obligation on its assets, provided however, that no payment
- 4 obligation exceeds the amount that a property tax would be charged
- 5 to a similar asset.
